Monte Ito Memorial Scholarship Award

THE PROGRAM

Under the sponsorship of the Honolulu Advertiser, one \$1,500 college scholarship will be awarded to a Hawai'i high school senior or college student from Hawai'i at the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year. It will be named in honor of Monte Ito, the late Advertiser sportswriter. This scholarship will recognize outstanding achievement or potential in journalism and golf, and an appreciation of both.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student who, in the opinion of the judges, submits the best essay illustrating a passion for journalism and golf. Examples of published work can also be submitted to enhance an entry.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to seniors expecting to graduate from any Hawai'i high school at the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year, or current college students from Hawai'i who have at least one year of school remaining. Entrants need not be planning to major in journalism.

HOW TO ENTER

Entries must be received by Friday, May 21, 2010. Winners will be notified soon after. Entries must be mailed or delivered to:

REQUIREMENTS

Entrants are required to submit:

1. A one-to-two page essay illustrating your interest in journalism and golf.
2. This completed entry form (see back).

A resume (highlighting journalism and/or golf achievements) and up to three samples of your work can be included to enhance your entry. You may submit only one entry annually.

JUDGING

An independent panel of professional journalists will judge the entries.
